2. Department ARTP Committee forwards recommendation to College RT Committee and sends written notification of this recommendation to candidate.	Sept. 18 (Fri.)
3. College RT Committee forwards recommendation to Vice President for Academic Affairs and sends written notification of this recommendation to candidate.	Oct. 2 (Fri.)
4. Vice President for Academic Affairs forwards Recommendation to President and sends written notification of this recommendation to candidate.	Oct. 28 (Wed.)
5. Last day for filing substantive* appeal to the President	Nov. 9 (Mon.)
6. President forwards nomination to Board of Trustees Academic Policy and Personnel Committee and sends written notification of this nomination to candidate.	Nov. 13 (Fri.)
7. Board receives nomination from its Academic Policy and Personnel Committee and takes action	Dec. 4 (Fri.)
8. Last day for formal notification by Board of Trustees to candidate for reappointment.	Dec. 11 (Fri.) **
