**Union, NJ**— Children ages 7 to 12 will enjoy getting into the holiday spirit at two fun, festive activities hosted by Liberty Hall Museum.

The Liberty Hall staff is calling on children ages 7 to 12 to help decorate the Victorian Christmas tree by creating Victorian style-Christmas ornaments. Each child will create four ornaments, two for the Liberty Hall tree and two to bring home. The price is \$8 per child. Prepaid reservations are required and may be made by calling 908-527-0400. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

'Tis also the season for Liberty Hall's Gingerbread House Workshops. Space fills up quickly for this popular, annual Liberty Hall event, so make your prepaid reservations quickly! The workshop is recommended for ages 7-12. The price is \$15 per child. Reservations are required and may be made by calling 908-527-0400. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

Liberty Hall Museum at Kean University chronicles more than 200 years of New Jersey and U.S. history. It was the home of William Livingston, the first elected governor of New Jersey and a signer of the Constitution, and houses extensive collections of antique furniture, ceramics, textiles, toys and tools owned by seven generations of the Livingston/Kean families. The latest addition to the Museum's complex is the Firehouse, which houses two antique fire engines and a collection of fire memorabilia. Liberty Hall Museum recently took another historical step when it announced its partnership with Kean University.

Liberty Hall is located at 1003 Morris Avenue in Union, New Jersey. The museum is open to the public Wednesday through Saturday, 10 am to 4 pm, and Sunday from noon to 4 pm.
