As a Freshman, you should currently be **enrolled** in your **Composition class**. As appropriate and recommended by your advisor, please enroll in or continue with Composition in Fall 2008 by registering for **ENG 1030, 1031/1032, or 1034**.

To receive advisement in the Department, obtain the name of your **primary Department advisor** on KeanWise and then check his/her availability on the advisement schedule also posted in this section. Feel free to contact your advisor, especially for an appointment outside posted times, or to seek advisement on a walk-in basis, using the schedule above for reference. Click on the faculty section to access office hours and contact information for all advisors.

Please refer to the guidelines below to help you with the registration process:

1. **Pick up** copies of the brochures and major guide sheets for the English major from the literature racks outside CAS 301, if you have not already done so.
2. **Keep track** of the courses you take on your major guide sheet and always bring it with you to advisement sessions. If you are a transfer student, please bring any transfer credit documentation you may have.
3. **EEO, EPIC, and PASSPORT students:** You must report to your program advisor after receiving advisement from the English Department.
4. Please **print a copy of your transcript** from KeanWISE for your advisement session so that your advisor can review the courses you've already completed.
