If you are a **new transfer** and/or a new major, or if you are in your **first or second semester** as an English major, or if you have only been advised by the English Department one time (or not at all), you **MUST** come to CAS 301 for **in-person advisement**.

\*When you do so, please bring your *major guide sheet* and any *transfer credit documentation* you may have (if this applies to you).

As a sophomore:

1. You must take **ENG 2000: Writing about Literature NOW** if you have not already done so.
2. Please take **ENG 2001: Critical Approaches to Literature** the semester following ENG 2000.
3. You should also work on your survey requirements and take your linguistics course.\*
