About Upward Bound:

The Kean University Upward Bound Program is a federally funded pre-college preparatory program designed to assist high school students who have the ability and motivation necessary to pursue a program of post-secondary education following high school graduation.

Upward Bound gives high school students an opportunity to learn first-hand what college life is all about and helps the students in the development of the skills necessary to succeed in college. The program emphasizes reading, writing, mathematics, science, foreign language, and study skills.

To qualify for the program, you must meet the following criteria:

- Must have completed the 8th grade, but not have entered the 11th grade.
- Must be attending high school in East Orange or Elizabeth, NJ.
- Must be a potential first-generation college student (neither parent has earned a four year college degree) and/or must meet the U.S. Department of education income guidelines.
- Must show academic need for Upward Bound services.
- Must have interest and commitment to furthering education beyond high school.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident.

As an Upward Bound participant, you will receive

- Year-round intensive academic instruction in mathematics, reading, language arts, literature, science, foreign language, and study skills;
- ➤ One on one and/or group, academic, financial literacy and personal counseling;
- Personalized assistance in completing admission tests, college admission, applications, and financial aid and scholarship applications.
- ➤ College visits:
- > Career education and exploration;
- ➤ Leadership and tea building activities;
- > Cultural enrichment activities;
- > Opportunities to travel to other U.S. Cities.
