				Students qualify for induction into Tri-Alpha if they meet the following criteria: The student has earned at least 30 credit/semester hours towards a baccalaureate degree (including half-time) AND The undergraduate student has achieved an overall undergraduate GPA of at least 3.2 on a 4.0 scale. Neither the student's parents nor legal guardians completed a bachelor's degree. Graduate students who are first-generation students can be admitted if they have completed the equivalent of at least one term of study (9 or more graduate credits) and have a GPA in their graduate program of at least 3.5. (NOTE: Part-time students in graduate programs cannot be admitted.)
