



SUMMATIVE SCORE

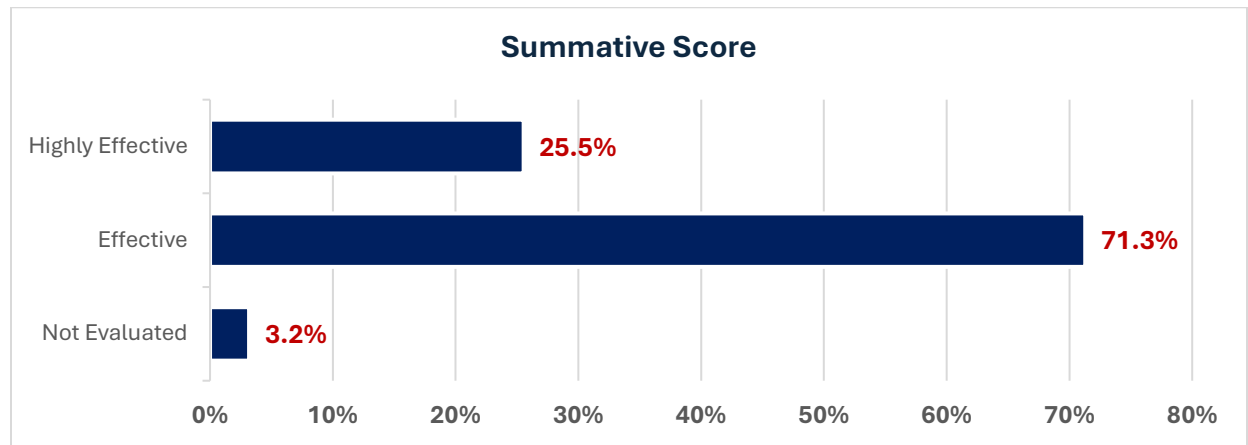

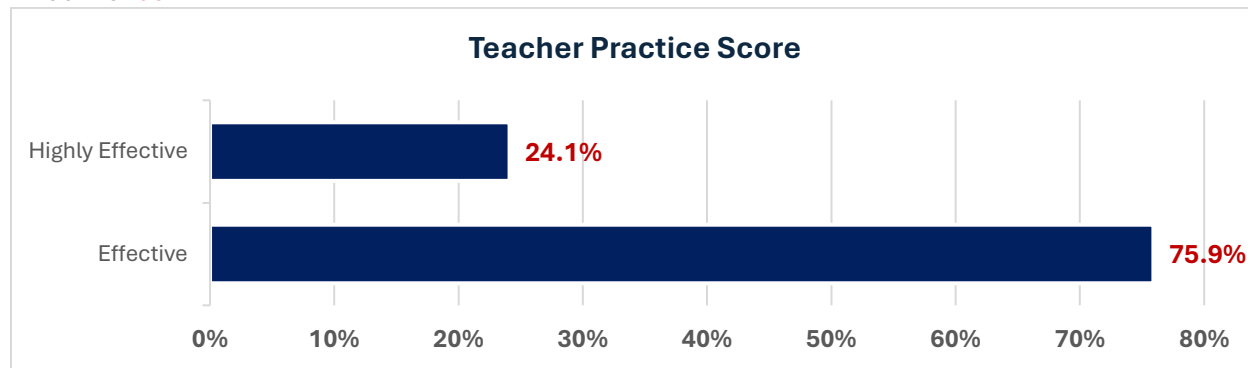
TEACHER PRACTICE SCORE

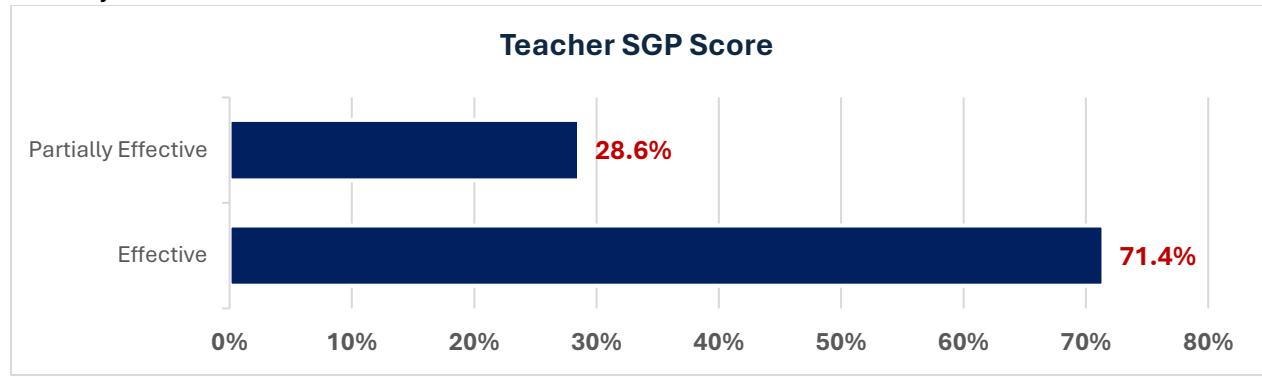
TEACHER SGP SCORE

The combined score for a teacher’s Student Growth Objectives as assessed by the district’s evaluation system for assigning teacher or principal performance ratings.

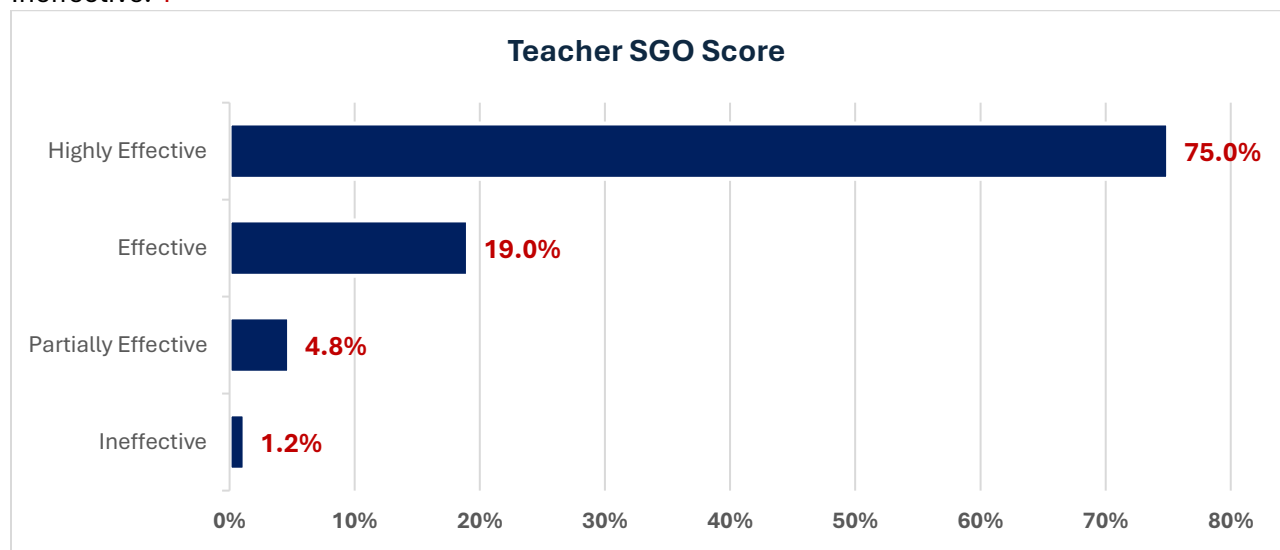
