2026 Group Summer Scholars Research Program

FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

The program cost for the 2026 GSSRP is \$3,000 (early discount deadline) / \$5,000 per student for the Full Four-week session and \$1,500 (early discount deadline) / \$3,000 for the Two-week Micro-session. Students from low-income families are eligible for fee waivers to cover this cost. Other students may be considered for full or partial scholarships based on financial need.

Criteria for scholarships is listed below.

Students will be qualified for a fee waiver if the combined annual household income of the student's parents is \$26,500 or less for a family of four (as reported on the most recent federal income tax return). Students, whose parents' combined household income exceeds the above listed threshold, will also be considered for a full scholarship if **three or more** of the following criteria are met:

The student's household receives benefits from any of the following designated means-tested federal benefit programs:

- Medicaid

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI) Program

- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)

- Free and Reduced Price School Lunch Program

- Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) Program

- Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC)

The student self-identifies as a minority historically underrepresented in STEM (Alaskan Native, Native American, Black or African American, Hispanic, Native Hawaiian or other Pacific Islander)

English is a second language for the student

The student is a potential first-generation college student (parents did not attend college)

AND the combined annual household income of the student's parents is \$50,000 or less (as reported on the most recent federal income tax return).

Students who do not meet the criteria above may be considered for full or partial scholarships based on documentation of extenuating circumstances.

The main application for the GSSRP will include a section on financial assistance and must be completed for a student to be considered for a fee waiver or scholarship. If this section is left blank, no financial aid will be considered.
