GENERAL INFORMATION

<u>Free Electives</u>: At least 50% of Free Electives must be at 3000-4000 level. English majors may not use ENG major courses as Free Electives. Free Electives can be used to complete a minor (generally 18-24 credits) in another discipline. <u>Summer Courses</u>: Kean offers two summer sessions each year., and Wenzhou Kean offers one summer session each year Students may take two courses (or seven credits, whichever is greater) in each summer session. Summer courses are recommended as a way to stay on track for four year graduation if fewer credits than recommended are completed during regular semesters.
