All students are eligible to take PSRT-1101 and PSRT-1102. However, only declared majors may take classes beyond the above two course. Students must submit an application to the School of Psychology in order to become “Declared Majors.” All students need to be eligible before they can submit an application. Eligibility requires the following: a) At least 40 credits; b) 2.5 overall GPA; c) 3.0 GPA in Psychology and Psychiatric Rehabilitation classes; d) Completed at least 9 credits of Psychology classes.
