- 3. A grade of "C" or better must be earned in ENG 1030, all major courses, and the Capstone.
- 4. Students whose qualifying score on the placement test makes them eligible to take either MATH 1054 or MATH 2411 may take that course instead. In that case, either MATH 1054 or MATH 2411 will count as the General Education requirement and the student must take 3 or 6 credits as Free Electives to total 124 s.h.
- Credit granted only upon completion of both semesters of elementary or intermediate foreign language. Three credits may be applied to Humanities and three credits may be applied to Free Electives.
- 6. A grade of "C" or better must be earned in CHEM 1083-84; prerequisite to CHEM 3181.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) REQUIREMENT FOR THE MAJOR

- 1. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 at the time of application for acceptance as a declared Major.
