### Grade Point Average (GPA) Requirement for the Major

The Biological Sciences program has formally adopted the following standard for all options of the Biology major Teacher Certification Option:

1. Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 at the time of application for acceptance as a declared major.
2. Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 must be maintained in order to remain in the Biology major.
3. To be accepted in a professional education program, students must have and maintain a combined GPA of 3.0 and complete the required admission procedure.

Comments:

New Jersey requires a passing score on the Praxis II examinations, Biology: Content Knowledge Part 2 and General Science: Content Area Parts 1 and 2 as partial fulfillment of the teacher certification requirement.

The tests must be taken and passed PRIOR to EMSE 4811 Professional Field Internship (student teaching). Also, passing Praxis II scores must be on file in the Teaching Performance Center of Kean University (Willis Hall 110) before taking EMSE 4811. Passing Praxis II scores in each area of certification are determined by the NJ Department of Education and are subject to change.

Criteria for acceptance into Teacher Education Programs:

- A. Minimum GPA of 3.0 (combined from all institutions of higher education attended).
- B. Completion of the following courses/minimum grades:
  - ENG 1030 College Composition (minimum grade of B-)
  - COMM 1402 Speech Comm As Critical Citizenship (minimum grade of B-)
  - EMSE 2801 Intro to Field Experience in Subject Area K-12 (minimum grade B-)
  - Laboratory Science course (minimum grade of C)
  - Math requirement (minimum grade of C)
- C. Passing score on the Praxis Core Academic Skills Test
- D. Completion of the Speech/Language Screening test available from the Child Study Institute.
- E. All applicants must file a formal application for admission with the office of the major department and have an admissions interview with the program coordinator.
