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Evaluation of prerequisite courses for transfer credit is based on policies established by Kean University and the faculty of the Nursing Department.

All prerequisite courses and major requirements must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.

Lower division nursing credits are granted upon admission.

A minimum of 32 credits must be taken at Kean.

Fifty (50%) of the nursing major credits must be completed at Kean

Before taking General and/or Subject CLEP exams, contact your faculty advisor regarding policies and procedures. Any General Exam must be taken before earning a total of 30 credits towards your degree (Kean and/or transfer credits). Any Subject Exam must be taken before earning a total of 86 credits (Kean and/or transfer credits).
