We encourage you to take advantage of CRM Advise to assist in the advisement process. CRM Advise can be accessed through the dropdown QUICKLINKS menu on the <u>Kean homepage</u>. There is a link for instructors of classes (Faculty Experience); one for faculty advisors (Advisor Experience); and one for students (Student Experience). We strongly encourage you to use the office hour feature in the Advisor Experience which allows for the listing of office hour appointments for virtual advisement.
