Prior to admission to the Department of Early Childhood/Family Studies, the following criteria must be met:

Entry Requirements – All required to move from “Intended” to “Declared” Major

- ❑ A cumulative grade point average of **2.75** or better;
- ❑ A speech and language screening test (register online <<http://www.kean.edu/~cdd>, or call 908-737-5819 for an appointment, or sign up on the door of L-104, East Campus);
- ❑ A passing score on the **PRAXIS I** exam (PPST-Pre-professional Skills Test). Register online with Educational Testing Service <<http://www.ets.ort/praxis>>;
- ❑ An interview with a member of the department, either in the exit interview for EC 2900 or, in the case of transfer students, by a Department Chairperson or designee;
- ❑ A minimum grade of “C” in COMM 1402: Speech Communication;
- ❑ A minimum grade of “C” in ENG 1030: Composition;
- ❑ A minimum grade of “C” in at least one college-level math course;
- ❑ A minimum grade of “C” in BIO 1000: Biology;
- ❑ A minimum grade of “C” in GE 2022: Research & Technology;
- ❑ Satisfactory completion (with a grade of “C” or better) of Introductory Field, EC 2900: Field Experiences in Multi-cultural Early Childhood Settings or, in the case of transfer students, an equivalent experience.

Exit Requirements

- ❑ A cumulative grade point average of **2.75** or better;
- ❑ Satisfactory completion of all course requirements;
- ❑ Passing scores on the Praxis II exams (10014: Elementary Content Knowledge _____ and 10022: Early Childhood Content Knowledge _____)
- ❑ Completion of the Teacher Work Sample requirement in EC 4000.
