The deadline for receipt of the Self-Nomination Form is Tuesday, February 28, 2025, at 11:59 pm.

The university senate is pleased to announce the elections for 2025-2026 and seeks self-nominations from candidates to fill vacancies on the Senate, the University Senate Standing Elected Committees, and the KFT Letter of Agreement Committees for the 2025-2026 academic year.

Eligible candidates are invited to self-nominate to fill vacant positions for the Senate and the committees. The self-nominations will be collected online via Qualtrics. Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to access the self-nomination form.

We urge those considering self-nomination to understand the vital responsibility of serving and attending meetings. Please do not seek elective office at this time if you plan to take a leave of absence, sabbatical leave, faculty exchange, or any other project that would prevent you from serving the entire term of office.

* Anyone wishing to serve on the Senate must save this date and be available to attend this meeting at which the new Executive Committee and the new Officers are elected.

Rules observed in certifying nominees for the Spring 2025 University Senate election:

- 1. The term for members of the Full University Senate is three years. (Ten Senators are elected each spring.)
- 2. Unless specified otherwise, all committee terms are for two years. Members of each respective college shall vote for and elect representatives to committees. Terms for some positions are sometimes adjusted to ensure staggering membership of the committees.
- 3. During any University Senate election, a candidate can run for the University Senate and/or two committees, including University Senate Standing Elected Committees and Letter of Agreement Committees.
- 4. No department may have two representatives serving on the same University Senate committee.
- 5. No department may have representation for more than two consecutive terms on any University Senate standing elected committees.
- 6. No department can succeed a member of the same department (elected or appointed) for at least one year.
- 7. No individual may consecutively serve for more than two terms, regardless of whether the terms were by election or appointment.
- 8. When an appointed member and an elected member are in the same department, the elected member's seat holds precedence. An appointed voting member should not be from the same department already represented on the same committee.
- 9. Concerning the Letter of Agreement committees, at any time, no more than two professional staff from the same division and no more than one professional staff from any one area within a division, as defined in the Letter of Agreement, shall serve on the same committee.

Please note:

- 1. According to the criteria outlined above, criteria for specific committees in the Senate Constitution, and the Manual for Senate Nominations and Election Committees, all nominations are verified for the candidate's eligibility. The eligibility check will occur before the publication of the final candidate list on March 4.
- 2. The following pages list specific eligibility criteria for selecting nominees after the committee's name.
- 3. <u>The division of General Studies & Interdisciplinary Studies faculty votes with the College</u> of Liberal Arts.

VACANCIES / OPEN POSITIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

University Senate

Meeting Times: General Body Meeting, 1st & 3rd Tuesday, 3:15 to 4:15 pm Executive Board Meeting, 2nd & 4th Tuesday, 3:15 to 4:15 pm. Vacancies: Ten positions (see distribution below); Three-year term Faculty – 8 positions (faculty vote for faculty) KFT bargaining unit professional staff – 1 position (professional staff votes for professional staff) Non-unit managers – 1 position (Non-unit managers vote for non-unit managers)
 Eligibility: All full-time classroom teaching faculty members; full-time professional librarians; full-time KFT bargaining unit professional staff; and non-unit managers. *Note: A Senator must be off the Senate for one year after two consecutive threeyear terms before running again. Thus, no Senator completing their second consecutive three-year term may run in this election.*
