The student health portal is your access to Student Health Services from submitting immunization documents to registering for appointments. All students need to register to activate their PyraMED portal account and start receiving the benefits of this secure patient portal. To activate and access the portal to Kean.studenthealthportal.com

- Submit your immunization documentation.
- Make or cancel office appointments at your convenience from home, residence hall or anywhere you have computer access.
- Get an appointment for a time that fits your schedule
- Save time by completing office forms before you visit
- Communicate confidentially and securely with our health care providers via Secure Messages
- Access and print your lab results when they are ready.

Student Health Services is here to support the health and wellness of today's busy college student by providing cost effective, high quality, accessible health care. Student Health Services is available to all registered Kean University students.

- Assessment and treatment of illness/injuries
- Full-time Nurse Practitioners
- Part-time Physician coverage
- Prescription Medications, laboratory tests and diagnostic tests if indicated
- HIV testing, free and confidential
- Sexual Transmitted Infection evaluation and treatment
- Tuberculosis testing
- Laboratory testing-onsite
 - Strep throat, UA, Pregnancy, STIs, HIV, Blood glucose
- Laboratory testing - off site (with insurance)
 - Titers for immunity to Hepatitis B and MMR, sickle cell, etc.
- Women's health exam
- Men's health exams
- Physicals for academic requirements
- Nutrition and wellness counseling
- Up to date health related information
- Health education (pamphlets/speakers)
- Referrals to offsite specialists, if indicated
- Mono testing
- PrEP/PEP counseling

No information about a student will be released without the student's prior written consent, unless there is a clear and present danger to an individual's safety or the safety of others.

IMMUNIZATIONS & INSURANCE

The State of New Jersey mandates immunization requirements for all Kean University students. For detailed information about these requirements and how to submit documentation visit our website at www.kean.edu/immunizations.

SUBMIT YOUR IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS IN 4 SIMPLE STEPS

1. Visit our site, <https://goo.gl/uvZtRA>, print out the Immunizations Form, and take to your health care provider for completion.
2. Once the form is completed, signed, and stamped by your healthcare provider, log in to the Kean University Student Health Portal, kean.studenthealthportal.com
3. Go to the My Forms tab, select the Immunizations History form, and enter your immunization dates.
4. Upload your form for verification in Document Upload tab.

You will receive a secure message to your Kean e-mail within 5 business days once your immunizations are verified and/or if additional information is required.



INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Federal law requires all citizens to have health insurance. **Residential students and students enrolled in the Center for International Studies program must provide proof of insurance at the start of every academic year.**
