Program Overview

Lay the foundation for your pharmaceutical career by completing prerequisite coursework and the first three years of your Chemistry B.A. at Kean University.

Apply to the dual program in your second year and upon acceptance, complete the senior year of your bachelor's program at Howard and subsequent three additional years to earn your Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) degree.

Only applicants who are truly committed to persevering until they successfully achieve their Pharm.D. should apply.

Requirements

- Have an overall GPA of 2.5.
- Complete all prerequisite coursework for the Chemistry B.A. degree at Kean University.
- Engage in an interview process, including a 15-minute virtual interview with the committee.
- Submit a written statement about your aspirations to become a pharmacist.
- Successfully pass a math exam conducted on-site at Howard University.
- Provide three written recommendations (from Kean science or math professors and/or a working pharmacist).

Apply to the dual program in your second year and upon acceptance, complete the senior year of your bachelor's program at Fairleigh Dickinson University and subsequent three additional years to earn your Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) degree.

Only applicants who are truly committed to persevering until they successfully achieve their Pharm.D. should apply. Complete FDU application at least 1 year prior to FDU matriculation date.

Requirements

- Have an overall GPA of 3.0 with minimum GPA of 2.5 in all math and science courses.
- Complete all prerequisite coursework for the Chemistry B.A. degree at Kean University.
- Engage in an interview process, including a 15-minute virtual interview with the committee.
- Submit a written statement about your aspirations to become a pharmacist.
- Non-citizen applicants whose native language is not English are required to achieve a minimum score of 79 on TOEFL iBT.
- Provide three written recommendations (from Kean science or math professors and/or a working pharmacist).
