The program will present the four Interprofessional Educational Collaborative (IPEC) competencies: values and ethics; roles and responsibilities; communication; and teams and teamwork. The learner outcomes include: (a) identify interprofessional competencies; (b) evaluate individual and group experience in interprofessional practice; (c) strategize ideas for positive change in interprofessional practice.
