WHEREAS: The University also recognizes the need to continue to strategically invest in its

The Kean University Board of Trustees approves the recommended average 3.5% increase in tuition and fees in FY2024 for all full-time and part-time undergraduate, graduate and online students, both in-state and out-of-state, and all academic programs (with the exception special undergraduate, graduate and online cohort programs whose rates will be established in a separate Board resolution); and, be it further

The Board authorizes this increase to cover the University's proposed budget for FY24 and related expenses; and, be it further

"one price" tuition guarantee, are limited to only one cohort discount, and the greater discount would be applied to the tuition bill; and, be it further

- \$75 administrative fee per student at partner school districts to complete a Kean-issued pass/fail assessment in conjunction with University-approved curriculum for the issuance of credit;
