



Kean University Mandatory Immunization Requirements

FOR STUDENTS BORN AFTER 12/31/56:

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)

- MMR two dose series
- Dose number one must be on or after 1st birthday and after 12/31/67
- Dose number two must be at least 30 days after 1st dose
- Or if your vaccination records are not available, you may provide proof of immunity with a blood test (MMR IgG antibodies). A copy of your laboratory report/results are required. Please note, if you are not immune, the State requires you to receive the appropriate vaccinations.

And additional vaccines as indicated in the categories below.

FOR STUDENTS UNDER AGE 18:

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) two dose series as above

Meningococcal A, C, Y, W-135 one dose on or after age 16

- Resident students are required to complete the Meningitis Survey within the Immunization History form in the patient health portal

And additional vaccines as indicated in the categories below.

FOR STUDENTS REGISTERED for 12 or MORE CREDITS:

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) two dose series as above

Meningococcal A, C, Y, W-135 as above, for students who are under age 18.

Hepatitis B three dose series or Hepatitis B two dose series (valid if given ages 11-15)

- Or if Hepatitis B vaccination records are not available, you may provide proof of immunity with a blood test (Hepatitis B surface Antibodies). A copy of your laboratory reports/results are required. Please note, if you are not immune, the state requires you to receive the appropriate vaccinations.

And additional vaccines as indicated in the categories below.



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FOR STUDENTS LIVING IN UNIVERSITY HOUSING:

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) two dose series as above

Meningococcal A, C, Y, W-135 one dose on or after age 16, prior to check-in

- Resident students are required to complete the Meningitis Survey within the Immunization History form in the patient health portal

Hepatitis B as above

And additional vaccines as indicated in the categories below.

FOR STUDENTS RESIDING IN THE U.S. WITH A STUDENT VISA AND ARE REGISTERED WITH THE CENTER FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDIES:

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) two dose series as above

Meningococcal A, C, Y, W-135 as above and according to the below categories

- Students under the age 18
- Residents of a country where meningococcal disease is prevalent
- Students living in university housing. Resident students are required to complete the Meningitis Survey within the Immunization History form in the patient health portal

Hepatitis B as above

Tuberculin Skin Test Within 6 months of the start of the first semester. If skin test results are positive, documentation of a chest x-ray is required

And additional vaccines as indicated in the categories below.

FOR STUDENTS THAT ARE IMMUNOCOMPROMISED OR TAKING MEDICATIONS THAT MAY ALTER THE IMMUNE SYSTEM, WITH ASPLENIA OR BLOOD DISORDERS, OR THAT WORK IN A LABORATORY WITH MENINGOCOCCAL BACTERIA (NEISSERIA MENINGITIDIS):

Meningococcal A, C, Y, W-135 one dose on or after age 16

Meningococcal B two or three doses, Trumenba or Bexsero must be designated at the time of documentation

FOR STUDENTS THAT ARE POSITIVE TO HIV INFECTION:

Meningococcal A, C, Y, W-135 one dose on or after age 16
