SELECTING A MEAL PLAN

Students residing on campus next academic year will be able to go in and select their meal plan through the housing portal this summer!

PROCESS

The Office of Residence Life will open a late housing selection process beginning April 24th and remain open until July 31st.

HOUSING APPLICATION CANCELLATIONS

Residents who may have applied for housing but will no longer be residing on campus must cancel their housing by June 18th to avoid a late cancellation fee.









Spring move-outs will take place from Wednesday, May 3, 2023, through Wednesday, May 10, 2023. Below are guidelines for completing your move-out:

Appointments

Schedule an appointment with your RA by Monday, May 1, 2023. Students must move out within 24 hours of their last final.

How to Prepare

While preparing to move out, all residents must ensure they complete the following:

- Ensure that the bedroom/suite is clean
- Discard all items in their refrigerator/ freezer
- Empty trash cans
- Close and secure windows
- Leave window shades up
- Turn off all lights
- Lock (close) front door and bedroom door

During Check Out

During your scheduled check, residents will be permitted to have two guests assist them. RAs will be checking for cleanliness and damages; all furniture must be returned to its original position. Residents must sign the final inspection form, sign the inventory sheet, and turn in their keys.


BURCH HALL
