

1. To examine current policies governing the use of the Learning Commons and to recommend changes in these policies to the University Senate for consideration.
2. To annually assess the quality and services of the library and address concerns raised by students, faculty, and staff in these areas, reporting the findings to the University Senate.
3. To act as a liaison between the library and the University Senate.
4. To ensure that the library's services are widely publicized among students, faculty, and staff, including developing a frequently asked questions (FAQs) sheet regarding library services.
5. To suggest to the University Senate ways of improving and expanding the library functions that aid in academic support.
6. To advocate for the library before the Administration and Board of Trustees.
7. To have the chair of this committee or designee serve as a member of the University Library Liaison Committee to facilitate communication between departments and the Library Committee and bring issues from the liaisons to the Library Committee.
8. To fulfill any specific or special charges from the University Senate.
9. To provide mid-year and end-of-the-academic-year reports to the University Senate, summarizing progress, findings and recommendations.
10. To advocate for adequate staffing of the library with librarians to support the integration of digital literacy and research skills into academic programs, and to collaborate with faculty and departments in aligning library instruction with course and program learning outcomes.
