# 2023-2024 Application Requirements

Students seeking Financial Aid for the 2023-2024 Academic Year must complete the following:

- 2023-2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- 2023-2024 New Jersey Tuition Aid Grant (TAG): awarded through the NJ Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA)

# **KEAN The Application Process**

- File the FAFSA electronically prior to every academic year beginning October 1st
  - FAFSA Free Application: www.fafsa.gov
  - Student & Parent must create a Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID) at www.fsaid.ed.gov
- Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool to populate income & tax information.
- Kean University School Code: 002622

# After the FAFSA is filed...

- Student Aid Report (SAR) is sent to student and to the schools listed on the FAFSA
- Email notifications are sent by NJ Higher Education Student Assistance Authority (HESAA) to inform NJ students of NJ State grant eligibility
- Award Letter notifications are emailed to students via their Kean email accounts
- All other communications are sent via Kean email
- Students may receive request for additional information from both Kean University and HESAA due to federal/state verification

# Federal Direct Student Loans for Undergraduates: Subsidized/Unsubsidized

- Fixed Interest Rate: 4.99% \*
- Origination Fee: 1.057%
- Interest on the loan accrues while borrower is in school.
- Student borrower must complete online Entrance Counseling and the Direct Loan Master Promissory Note (MPN).

# Direct Loan Entrance Counseling and MPN

- Student planning on accepting the Federal Direct Student Loans are required to complete Entrance Counseling and the Master Promissory Note (MPN).
- Go to <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>
- FSA ID and Password are required.

Federal Direct Parent PLUS Loans for Parents of Dependent Undergraduate

- Fixed Interest Rate: 7.54% \*
- Interest on the loan accrues while borrower is in school.
- Parent borrower must complete a Direct Loan Master Promissory Note (MPN).

## **Private Educational Loans**

- Private loans are credit based loans.
- A co-signer may be required.
- Maximum award per year cannot exceed the cost of attendance minus all other sources of financial aid.
- Fixed Interest & Variable Interest Rates available
- You must include the full school code for a private loan: Kean University School Code: 002622
- Access at www.elmselect.com

## **Cost of Attendance (COA)**

- The COA includes:
  - the actual direct (billed charges) and
    indirect costs (books, transportation, commuting costs)
- Financial aid can be awarded up to the total COA.

# Satisfactory Academic Progress

The student must earn a minimum cumulative grade-point average that meets the requirements for continuing enrollment and graduation as defined by the college. Satisfactory academic progress runs each year after the spring semester. Meeting satisfactory academic progress is required for both Federal and State financial aid.

• Undergraduate Students: Minimum Cumulative 2.0 GPA

#### AND

• Students are also evaluated on pace of completion, meaning students must complete 66.67% of the credit hours in which they are registered.
