  - Released time to support research/creative activities of untenured faculty
- RTR Released Time for Research
  - Released time to support research/creative activity of all faculty
- SpF Students Partnering with Faculty
  - Faculty-student summer research project

# **UFRI**Untenured Faculty Research Initiative

- Open to all untenured faculty and librarians
- Limit two UFRI awards, then participate in RTR
- If declined can automatically go to RTR review
- 1 6 credits released time; no teaching overload
- Up to \$400 for related direct cost support
- Award period Academic year

### **RTR**

#### Released Time for Research and Creative Works

- Open to tenured/tenure-track faculty, librarians, and professional staff
- One renewal application per award; no lifetime limit
- 1 6 credits released time; no teaching overload
- Up to \$400 for related direct cost support
- Award period Academic year

#### **UFRI and RTR Application Elements**

- Applicant Information
- Proposal Title
- Proposal Abstract (500 words)
- Proposal Description
  - Objectives
  - Procedures and Methods
  - Expected Outcomes
  - Timeline
  - Faculty Qualifications/Related Publications

#### Review Criteria – UFRI and RTR

- Should be considered on its own merits
- Clearly indicates applicant has necessary competence to carry out and complete
- Methods detailed are adequate
- Likely to result in:
  - Publication in scholarly journal or major press
  - Presentation at major professional conferences;
     public performance/exhibit
  - Receipt of external funding

#### **UFRI/RTR Reviewer Comments**

- Competitive Proposals
  - Clearly written, understandable project
  - Need/enthusiasm comes through
  - Results are clear and achievable
- Common Weaknesses
  - Too technical/too much jargon
  - Unclear methodology
  - Overambitious plans and timelines
  - "Life's work" project no end in sight

# SpF Students Partnering with Faculty

- Open to all full-time faculty
- Undergraduate or masters graduate students enrolled and continuing in the fall
- Minimum of 2 / maximum of 3 students
- Two consecutive awards wait out a year
- \$3,500 faculty stipend total
- \$3,500 stipend per student
- \$2,000 direct project costs
- Minimum 6-week intensive summer research
- Award period: May 1 April 30

Committee Review February 3, 2020 - March 3, 2020

Committee Meeting March 5, 2020

Awards announced in March

#### **SpF Application Elements**

- Applicant Information
- Proposal Title
- Student Information
  - Class level, academic program, GPA
  - Past research activities
  - How will this project benefit you?
- Proposal Narrative
  - Scope and Impact
  - Goals and Methods
  - Timeline
  - Plans for Dissemination
- Faculty Statement
  - Level of interaction with students
  - Specific description of students' activities and responsibilities

## **SpF Review Criteria**

Project Significance - 40 points						
<ul> <li>Does the project relate to important issues in the discipline? Is the project aimed at new discovery, new knowledge or interpretation or original work?</li> </ul>	15					
<ul> <li>Are the goals and methods listed realistic?</li> </ul>	15					
<ul> <li>Is the timeline realistic? Does it follow the guidelines? (minimum 6 weeks intensive activity; continued work into the fall semester)</li> </ul>	10					
Faculty Impact – 20 points						
<ul> <li>Does the applicant make a case for how this project fits within their established research agenda and how it will be helpful for their career</li> </ul>	20					
Student Impact – 40 points						
<ul> <li>Is the level of faculty interaction with the students described in this application sufficient?</li> </ul>	15					
<ul> <li>Are the student research responsibilities described in enough detail?         Are you confident that the student will have an authentic research experience and research training? Does the student effectively express an interest in the research?     </li> </ul>	15					
<ul> <li>Does the dissemination plan include opportunity for the student to present, publish or perform?</li> </ul>	10

#### **SpF Reviewer Comments**

- Common weaknesses
  - Student narratives too brief; did not effectively express an interest in the research
  - Timeline not specific enough to determine 6 weeks of intensive summer activity
  - Faculty interaction with students not sufficient
  - Not identifying all students on the team

#### Suggestions

- Open an online application on November 1st you'll get a reminder before the deadline
- Untenured faculty apply FIRST to UFRI
- SpF design the summer experience around the students
- Consider applying to more than one program to achieve your objectives
- Take the application process seriously more is better
- Put some emotion into it
