# Eligibility

- Current Kean University resident or commuter
- Students who submit a 2021-2022 housing application by Friday, May 5, 2021
- Students who register for full-time classes for Fall 2022 and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 by the end of the Spring 2021 semester
  - A review of registration status and GPA will take place at the end of May for everyone who has selected a room.

# Important Dates

- May 5, 2021 by 4:00 p.m.: Deadline to submit housing application and pay application fee.
- May 12, 2021: Selection date and time emailed to eligible students.
- The Week of May 15, 2021: Online room selection begins.

# **Special Accommodations**

- Students requiring housing or meal plan accommodations due to a medical condition must contact the Office of Disability Services and submit a Medical Verification Form through their office.
- Deadline to submit Medical Verification Form: Friday, May 5, 2021.
- Office of Accessibility Services will assess the need of the accommodation, inform Residential Student Services of their approval, and the student will be contacted.

Step 5: Pay \$125 non-refundable application fee

# Step 6: Gender Inclusive Question

#### Roommate Group Selection

You may choose the people you are going to live with if you submit your application preferences before June 1, 2021. <u>All roommate groups must be complete by Room Selection or if is after Room</u> <u>Selection by Tuesday, June 1st at 11:59pm</u>.

PLEASE NOTE: In an effort to adhere to social distancing, we are making changes to the number of students allowed per suite. Instead of four students in a two-bedroom suite with two students in each bedroom, suites will now house one student per bedroom, two students per suite. As a result, groups may only consist of no more than two people.

If you would like a random suitemate, you may leave this section blank and go to the next page.

To participate in selection as part of a group:

- Click "Create Group" to begin the process of inviting others to your group.
- · Click "Invite" and search for the people you are inviting.
  - You can use their name and/or email to invite them.
    - If the search result reads " There was more than one Person record found" You must use the name and email to find the exact person.
- If you have already been invited to a group, you will see your invitation below. Click "Accept" to join the group, and "Decline" if you do not want to join the group.
- · If you have already accepted a group (your status is listed below as "Member")
- · if you wish to leave the group, click "Leave"
- You can only be in one group at a time, so if you are in a group and want to join a different group or create your own group, you must first leave the group you are in.

You can always re-log in and check the status of your roommate group.

# Step 7: Create a Roommate Group

- The leader will then select 'Invite' and search for the other members of the group

- If you have already been invited to a group, you will see the invitation when you log in. Click 'Accept' to join, or 'Decline' to not join.
  - If you have already accepted a group, your status will say 'Member'.
- You may only be in group at a time, so if you decide to change groups, you must first select 'Leave'
  - When done, click 'Select Group'
