



The following are items and activities that are prohibited in all the residence halls. Items are subject for confiscation if found in rooms during inspections or fire drills. Both items and prohibited activities are subject to disciplinary action in accordance with University policies and procedures.

ACTIVITIES

- ❑ **Covering smoke detectors or any action that interferes with the building fire detection system.**
- ❑ Use of or storage of hover boards anywhere on campus.
- ❑ Excessive accumulation of trash in the rooms. Take out your garbage regularly!
- ❑ Moving furniture to create barriers or obstructions which may hinder egress from the room.
- ❑ Failure to promptly evacuate upon activation of the fire alarm.
- ❑ False activation of the fire alarm or discharging of fire extinguishers.

ANIMALS

- ❑ No kind of animals allowed (except fish in a 10 gallon tank)

COOKING ITEMS

- ❑ Portable cooking appliances like rice makers/waffle makers/etc.
- ❑ Toaster ovens
- ❑ Toasters
- ❑ Electric grills
- ❑ Hot plates/Coffee Makers (Keurigs are allowed)
- ❑ Electric skilllets
- ❑ George Forman grills
- ❑ Microwaves
- ❑ Mini/regular-refridgerators (only those provided by the University)

ELECTRONICS

- ❑ Transmitting equipment/CB radios
- ❑ Radio and TV masts or aerials (indoor antennas excluded)

LIGHTING

- ❑ Kerosene lamps and other highly flammable substances (such as gas-containing devices)
- ❑ Neon signs and strings of lights (limited to 2 strings of decorative or xmas lights)
- ❑ Halogen lamps

MOTOR VEHICLES

- ❑ Motor vehicles of any kind, including, but not limited to, mopeds, motorcycles, and motorbikes

ROOM ITEMS

- ❑ Candles (including decorative candles)
- ❑ Incense
- ❑ Waterbeds
- ❑ Air Mattresses
- ❑ Fans with exposed blades
- ❑ Dart boards
- ❑ Weightlifting apparatus
- ❑ Music amplifiers
- ❑ Resonators
- ❑ Extension Cords
- ❑ Outlet adaptors (only surge protectors are allowed)
- ❑ Hair dryers requiring over 1500 watts of power
- ❑ Wall and Ceiling Hangins cannot exceed 50% of the aggregate wall space.
- ❑ Furniture such as chairs, couches, mattresses, etc., other than those provided by the University.

SMOKING/DRUGS/ALCOHOL

- ❑ Cigarettes/cigars/cigarillos/etc.
- ❑ Vapor pens
- ❑ Hookahs
- ❑ Electric Pens
- ❑ Drugs/narcotics
- ❑ Drug/narcotic paraphernalia
- ❑ Alcoholic beverages
- ❑ Alcohol containers empty or full
- ❑ Kegs of beer, "beer balls," or similar that are empty or full.

WEAPONS

- ❑ Firearms
- ❑ Paintball guns
- ❑ BB guns
- ❑ Fireworks
- ❑ Firecrackers
- ❑ Explosives
- ❑ Chemicals
- ❑ Any kind of knives
