When you create a PyraMED account you can:

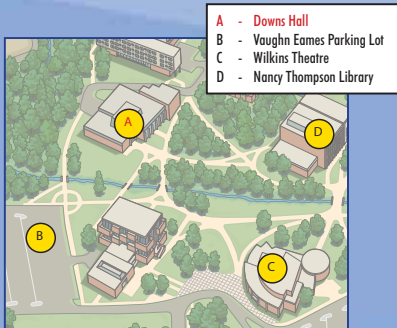
- Make or cancel office appointments at your convenience from home, residence hall or anywhere you have computer access.

Student Health Services has a variety of professionals to assist in dealing effectively with health issues and problems facing students in the 21st Century. We provide students with Nurse Practitioners and Physicians to meet your health related concerns. Student Health Services enables the “Student on the Go” to receive effective and beneficial medical treatment. Student Health Services is available to all registered University students, regardless of your health insurance provider.

Laboratory Testing

An on-site laboratory is available in order to assist with proper diagnosis and test for the following:

- Strep Throat
- Urinalysis
- Pregnancy
- Sexually transmitted infections

- HIV Testing
- Blood Glucose
- Immunity testing (Including immunization requirements)*
- Sickle Cell testing*
- Any necessary testing*

* testing is completed at an outside laboratory

Fit to be Kean Wellness

Fit to be Kean provides group exercise classes and FTBK wellness check- up appointments to keep you at optimum health. Students have access to all Fit to be Kean services as long as they are registered. A Kean ID must be present for each class. Group exercise classes motivate you to work out through the semester. A variety of classes may include: Zumba, Zumba Toning, Body Blast, Step Aerobics, High Intensity Training, Cardio Kickboxing, and/or Yoga. Immunizations & Insurance

Requirements for All Students

All students born after December 31, 1956: must submit proof of two measles vaccines, one mumps vaccine, and one rubella vaccine (MMR), all administered after your first birthday and after 12/31/67. The two measles vaccines must have been administered at least one month apart.

All new students taking 12 or more credits: must submit proof of the three-dose Hepatitis B series (or two-dose adult series as notated by the physician)

If your records are unavailable, you can take a blood test (Antibodies IgG for MMR or Surface Antibody for Hepatitis B) to prove immunity. A copy of the laboratory report is required.

All students must fill out the Immunization Requirement Forms which can found at www.kean.edu/immunizations

Housing Requirements

Meningitis Vaccine

All housing students must submit proof of meningitis vaccination before checking in at assigned residence halls. The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) recommends one (1) vaccine since age 16. All residents must fill out the Immunization Requirement Forms which can be accessed from www.kean.edu/immunizations

Proof of Insurance

All housing students are required to submit proof of a current health insurance plan. Follow the instructions to submit your insurance information

- Log into KeanWISE
- Click the “Students” tab.
- Under the “Other” heading, click the Residential and International Students Proof of Insurance Submission link.
- Enter your insurance information. A confirmation e-mail will be sent to your Kean e-mail account once this part is complete.

International Student Requirements

Tuberculosis Testing

All international students must submit proof of recent tuberculosis testing results. Testing records must be within the last 6 months. This test is also known as TB, PPD, or Mantoux. Recent QuantiFERON laboratory results are also accepted (BCG is not accepted).

Proof of Insurance

All international students are required to submit proof of a current health insurance plan. Please complete the verification process, explained in the Housing Requirements section above.

Confidentiality

Communication between a student and our staff is completely confidential. A student's health record is not part of his/ her academic record. No information about a student will be released without the student's prior written consent, unless there is a clear and present danger to an individual's safety or the safety of others.
