Committee Charges

Approved by University Senate on December 14, 2021

The domain of this committee involves matters relating to the Writing Emphasis Courses.

Standing Charges:

1. To work with stakeholders throughout the university to build a robust writing culture.
2. To provide clear guidelines and course requirements for Writing Emphasis classes:
3. To create procedures for approval of new Writing Emphasis courses.
4. To periodically review and update the definition of Writing Emphasis courses for the Undergraduate Catalog.
5. To identify and support appropriate personnel who will work to:
6. Investigate trends in writing in each discipline to understand faculty and student needs.
7. Foster faculty engagement in the development of student writing habits.
8. Assist faculty in infusing writing throughout their curricula in a meaningful and productive way.
9. Support student writing development.
10. To review, approve, or deny new requests for Writing Emphasis designation.
11. To fulfill any specific or special charges from the University Senate relating to Writing Emphasis.
12. To work towards meeting the University's Strategic Plans and other initiatives.
