Welcome Back



- Kean is excited to welcome students, faculty and staff back to campus for the 2021-2022 academic year.
- All students who are coming to campus for any reason are required to complete this safety training to learn what they can do to help protect the campus community from COVID-19 and reduce the spread of the virus.
- Together, we will create a safe campus for everyone.



Vaccinations and Testing

- To safeguard the health of the Kean community, students and employees accessing any University facilities in the Fall 2021 semester must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or receive a medical or religious exemption to the vaccination requirement.
- Students must submit their vaccination records through the PyraMED Patient Portal. Submission instructions are available <u>here</u>.



Vaccinations and Testing

- Students who receive medical or religious exemptions to the vaccination requirement must be tested for COVID-19 weekly during the semester.
- Testing is free of charge and available on campus.
- The testing schedule will be shared with unvaccinated students directly. Testing is mandatory. Anyone who does not comply will be subject to disciplinary action under the Kean <u>COVID-19</u> <u>Community Standards Policy for Students</u>.





Three Key Steps to Protect Your Health

- Everyone, regardless of vaccination status, is required to wear a mask inside all Kean buildings and classrooms.
- Wash your hands regularly or use hand sanitizer stations throughout campus if hand washing is not possible.
- Stay home if you are sick.

Mask Mandate



- Everyone, regardless of vaccination status, is required to wear a mask inside all Kean buildings and classrooms.
- The only exceptions to the mask mandate are:
 - when a person is in a private space, such as a residence hall room or personal office; or
 - when eating or drinking where careful attention is given to maintaining distance from others.
- Masks are available at the front desk of Kean Hall or Miron Student Center as well as in vending machines across campus.



Wash Your Hands

- Students are reminded to wash their hands regularly, including both sides, knuckles, between fingers, and under the nails for at least 20 seconds.
- Hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol content is available across campus and can be used when washing hands isn't possible.
- Disinfectants will also be available in classroom spaces.





Stay Home if You Are Sick

- Students who commute and are feeling sick SHOULD NOT come to campus and should consult their healthcare provider for assistance.
- Students who live on campus and are feeling sick should remain in their residence hall rooms and contact their resident assistant or residence hall director for support.
- Students who believe they have symptoms of COVID-19 should contact Student Health Services at (908) 737-4880 <u>before</u> coming to the office.



Helpful Reminders

- The entire Kean community is reminded that drinking directly from water fountains is not permitted. Fountains may be used to fill up cups or bottles only.
- Students who use public transportation should take extra precautions with regard to hand hygiene and remember to wear a face covering and bring hand sanitizer. Limit touching frequently touched surfaces. Wash your hands or use hand sanitizer upon arrival to campus.



Reporting COVID-19 Cases

- Students who test positive for COVID-19 must report their test results to the University. Click <u>here</u> for a submission form.

- Students should also report COVID-19 cases among any of their close contacts to receive information on quarantine protocols. The University will follow all state and federal guidelines on contact tracing.
