- **Ensure** you have complied with all university entrance requirements, e.g., immunization and admission requirements. Students who do not submit all the required documents are restricted from registering for classes. Ensure your high school has submitted your final high school transcript.
- Attend as many campus events as possible
- **Get involved** Participate in clubs, organizations, and extracurricular activities.
- Take care of your grades, attend tutoring sessions when needed.
- **Seek advisement,** ask your advisor(s) for guidance and available opportunities. Track your academic progress and register for classes early to avoid course cancellations and get a good schedule
- **Explore** majors and minors. If you are not sure about what major to pursue, attend the major/minor fair and do your own research into career options
- **Learn** how to read your student progress on Student Planning and review your graduation requirements to ensure you are on the right track
- Complete your FAFSA or the HESAA Alternative Financial Aid Application (for students who qualify under the Dream Act). Check your financial account to ensure you complete any requirements if selected for verification.
- Inquire about Scholarships start getting familiar with the requirements and application process.
- Start Exploring Careers Options; visit Career Services and inquire about internships and job opportunities in your field. Attend major related events.
- Prepare and take career-related exams, if applicable, e.g., Praxis.
