Seniors: 90 Credits or more

- Review and Update Your Resume: make sure you include relevant work experience and include any internships you have completed. If you do not have any work experience or internships, seek career counseling through the Office of Career Services.
- **Review possible jobs and the requirements.** Are you prepared for the workforce? You still have time to add internships and work experience to your resume. Connect with Career Services
- Graduate School: Check dates and requirements to ensure you do not miss the deadline
- Graduate Schools Exam Requirements, if you have not yet taken the exam, take time to prepare
- Letters of Recommendation are required for graduate school, and job applications make sure you identify faculty and supervisors that can give good recommendations on your behalf.
- **Continue to seek support,** your GPA is very important, make sure you maintain your grades.
- Advisement, plan ahead, review your program requirements and make sure you meet all graduation requirements.
- **Review** Student Planning and use Student Progress to plan your upcoming course schedule.
- **Apply for Graduation**: Graduation applications are open during late summer and early fall semesters; make sure you complete the application by the deadline.
- **Graduation**, monitor your email regularly and visit the commencement website for updates on graduation status, Senior Portraits, Caps, and Gowns, and commencement ceremonies.
