With summertime around the corner, we hope that you are able to find the time to enjoy the weather, relax, and celebrate your accomplishments!





Spring move-outs will take place from Tuesday, May 3, 2022, through Wednesday, May 11. Below are guidelines for completing your move-out:

Appointments

Schedule an appointment with your RA by May 1, 2022. Students must move out within 24 hours of their last final.

How to Prepare

While preparing to move out, all residents must ensure they complete the following:

- · Turn off all lights
- Empty trash cans
- Leave window shades up
- Close and secure windows
- Ensure that the bedroom/suite is clean
- Lock (close) front door and bedroom door
- Discard perishable items in their refrigerators
- Unplug appliances and electronics except for refrigerators

During Check Out

During your scheduled check, residents will be permitted to have two guests assist them. RAs will be checking for cleanliness and damages and all furniture must be returned to its original position. Residents must sign the final inspection form, sign the inventory sheet, and turn in their keys.
