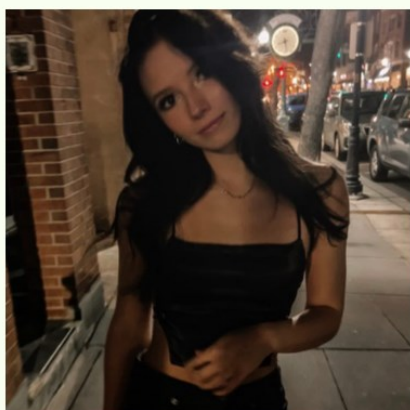


## JAHOD MATTHEWS

Grace Geyer is a freshman pursuing a major in Environmental Science. They have a keen interest in the outdoors, swimming, and eating watermelon!



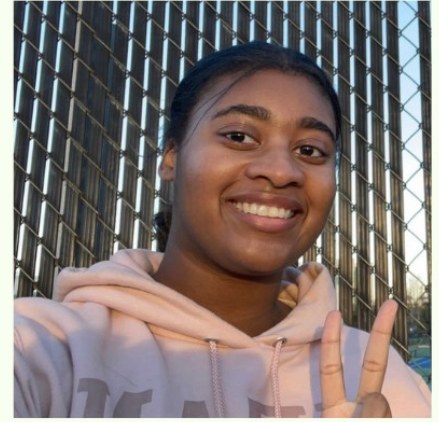
## ASHLEY KOCH
