HOUSING *Reminders*

PROHIBITED ITEMS

While residing on campus, specific items and activities are prohibited in all of the residence halls. Items are subject to confiscation if found in rooms during inspections or fire drills. Both items and prohibited activities are subject to disciplinary action in accordance with Kean University policies and procedures. GUEST POLICY

Students are permitted to invite outside guests, such as commuter students or family & friends, to visit them on campus. All non-residential students must present a valid state ID with a photo and home address on it (all international guests must present a passport at the time of arrival). Minors will not be permitted into the residence halls.

Residential students are permitted to host visitors overnight beginning May 22, 2023. Each student is allowed a maximum of fifteen overnight guests per semester, and all roommates and suitemates must approve all overnight visitors. Overnight guest forms and International guest forms can be found in your building's community center and must be submitted forty-eight hours or two business days in advance.
